### **Snowmobile Demo Ride event!** **Wednesday, January 12, 2011**

Please join us this day for an approximately 110-mile trail ride that leaves from our store, has a lunch stop on Mille Lacs Lake, and returns back here to our store late afternoon. We will have many various 2011 Arctic Cat demo sleds on this ride for you to ride and try in 10 mile increments.

We will have F Series sleds, Crossfires, Z1 1100's, Z1 Turbos, Bearcats, TZ1 Tourings and more. If you are considering a new Arctic Cat anytime soon and want to drive before you buy, this is your chance! You will be accompanied on the ride by staff from Thomas Sno Sports, representatives from Arctic Cat Inc, writers from American Snowmobiler magazine, and more. If Schedules allow, former and current members of Team Arctic will be in attendance.

At our lunch stop you will have an opportunity to try out some of our Tiger Trax equipped Arctic Cat Prowlers and Arctic Cat ATVs, and even a few old vintage Arctic Cat snowmobiles.

As this goes to print, the entire trail system we will travel has great snow cover and is going to be well groomed. The recent rains have brought about some areas of ice and we will be needing to exercise appropriate caution.



#### **A few things you will need to know...**

Preregistration is required. We can only accommodate the first 40 people to sign up, contact us as soon as possible to secure a spot.

No charge for the event, but, each person is responsible for the cost of their own lunch and gasoline in their sleds.



Each participant must have their own snowmobile with them to begin the ride. After the ride begins, you will be welcome to ride one of the demos as available and one of the staff members will be riding your snowmobile.

All brands of snowmobiles welcome at this event.

Please arrive here between 8 a.m. and 9 a.m. to get parked, unloaded, staged, dressed, sign release waivers, etc. The group will be leaving at 9:30 a.m. promptly.

The riding pace will be legal and safe, but fast. If that riding style makes you uncomfortable, you may want to join us on a future ride that is more suited to a relaxed riding style. This event will be held regardless of weather conditions.
